<u>Subject</u>: Holding of Central Excise Departmental Examination of Inspectors for confirmation from **09.12.2014** to **12.12.2014** - Reg.

As per Ministry's letter F.No.A-34011/1/2003 AD-III.A dated 13.08.03, NACEN has been conducting examination for different grade of the officers of the Department. The NACEN, RTI, Kanpur has been entrusted with responsibility for holding of Central Excise Departmental Examination of Inspectors for confirmation and such examinations are conducted on six monthly basis. The examination contains five papers of written examination and two viva-voce examination. The next such departmental examination for Inspectors will be held on <u>09,10,11 & 12 December</u>, <u>2014</u>. The Schedule of above said examination and syllabus are enclosed as **Annexure I & II**.

- 2. The eligibility of a candidate to appear in the above said examination is to be decided by the respective Cadre Controlling authority in terms of the Relevant Recruitment Rules. The Chief Commissioners / Director Generals / Commissioners may examine the eligibility of the same and sponsor the names of the eligible candidates.
- 3. The Cadre Controlling Authorities are requested to inform the eligible officers who are on deputation with other Directorates / Organizations and include their requirements also. The Cadre Controlling Authorities may kindly note that clarifications regarding eligibility of the candidates would fall outside the purview of NACEN and therefore, no correspondence on this account need to be forwarded to NACEN, RTI, Kanpur. The concerned authorities are required to ensure satisfaction of the eligibility conditions for appearing in this examination. Instruction contained in G.S.R.-217 issued by the Ministry of Finance (D.O.R.), New Delhi dated 12.12.2008 may also be referred in this regard.

- 4. Efforts would be made to ensure that <u>Question Papers reach your office</u> latest by 01.12.2014. The Question Papers intended for all the examination centers under your charge shall be sent to your office only. In case, question papers are not received by the given date, the same may be brought to the notice of the undersigned immediately. The dispatch / distribution of the packets containing question papers intended for other centers of examination may be done at your end. Concerned Commissionerates / Directorates are requested to make necessary arrangements to conduct the Departmental Examination on the scheduled dates.
- 5. Before conducting the examination, it may be mentioned that a unique Roll number is to be allotted to each participant by prefixing alphabets and then number (Text/Number) viz. "Insp/01". The name of Commissionerate should not be included while assigning Roll Number Code to the candidate so as to maintain confidentiality while processing the answer books.
- 6. It may be mentioned that the number of copies of Question paper (paper-wise) will be sent on the number of the candidates appearing for examination in the Chief Commissionerate Zone/Directorate. In case, number of officers increases in any paper after informing to this Academy as per Annexure-III, the examination of such officers may be conducted through photocopy of ONE EXTRA COPY which will be forwarded along with Question papers. If there is any addition of paper, which was not included or number of candidates was indicated 'Nil' at the time of furnishing information in Annexure-III, the same may be informed immediately so as to send the Question Paper to the Commissionerate / Directorate on time.
- 7. To enable this Academy to plan for preparation of the requisite number of question papers and their timely dispatch, requirement of such question papers (paper-wise) may kindly be sent in the prescribed proforma enclosed as Annexure-III to the <u>Additional Director General</u>, <u>NACEN</u>, <u>RTI</u>, <u>Kanpur</u>. The above said information / details may kindly be forwarded to this office latest by 14.11.2014 by <u>FAX</u>.
