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MINUTES OF THE PRE BID MEETING HELD ON 28/08/2023

In accordance with the conditions floated in the Tender Notice No. Bid Number/बोली; मांक (बड सं<या): GEM/2023/B/3856394 Dated/दनांक: 22.08.2023 floated by this office, a virtual pre-bid meeting on the tender pertaining to getting the decommissioned Aircraft dismantled systematically and transported to the designated location at Palasamudram and re-assembling & installation, renovation & refurbishment of the aircraft at the identified location in the Campus was held at 16.30 hrs on 28.08.2023. The pre bid meeting was scheduled as two prospective bidders had requested for a meeting. Link was shared with both prospective bidders through email. Out of the two, one prospective bidder attended the meeting. The meeting was attended by the following departmental Officers and bidder as under: -

- 1) Shri. Sujithkumar P. Sompur, Additional Director, NACIN, Bengaluru
- 2) Shri. Sainath B. Naik, Assistant Director, NACIN
- 3) Shri. N. Jayaram, Assistant Director, NACIN
- 4) Shri. Venkatesh, Blue Sky Aviation

2. As scheduled, the meeting started at around 16.30 hrs and Shri Sujith kumar P. Sompur, Additional Director, NACIN, Bengaluru welcomed the participants for the pre- bid meeting. Cap. V.R.Venkatesh, representing M/s Blue Sky Aviation Consultancy introduced himself and participated in the pre-bid meeting.

3. The following clarifications were sought by the representative of M/s Blue Sky Aviation Consultancy.

(i) Shri. Venkatesh enquired about the renovation of cockpit panels, both Pilot and Co-pilot of the Air Craft and sought to know whether they need to be in working condition and what is the requirement. It was clarified that as aircraft will be non working, cockpit panels etc., need not be

functional. At present, the cockpit is empty and it should be renovated with dummy to resemble cockpit environment.

(ii) To a query with regards to renovation of rear and forward toilets, Shri. Venkatesh enquired as to whether they can replace the parts such as windows, panels etc with their own fabricated parts/material, it was clarified that major portion of the toilets such as commode etc., are intact which can be verified by visiting the aircraft situated at Hyderabad and they can use their own fabricated parts such as panels etc for giving the toilets a neat and clean finished look.

(iii) Shri. Venkatesh informed that they are a micro unit with less than 05 crores turnover and asked whether the MSME exemption is available to them. It was clarified that if the bidder is legally entitled for exemption and if the proper and relevant documents are produced, the MSME exemption can be granted to them.

The meeting ended at around 17.00 hrs in a cordial manner.
