Press Release dated 22.08.2019 regarding the online written examination for Customs Brokers Examination, 2020 scheduled to be held on 06.03.2020 may be referred to. The pattern of the examination for the written and oral examination will be as follows:

The written examination will be a Computer Based Examination with Multiple Choice Questions. Questions will be bilingual ie. in English and Hindi. Other details regarding the written examination are as follows:

No. of questions : 150

Time duration : Two and half hours (10:30 hrs to 13:00 hrs)

Marking scheme : +3 for each correct answer

-1 for each incorrect answer

Maximum marks : 450

Qualifying marks : 270 (60%)

Those qualifying in the said examination will have to appear for oral examination in terms of Regulation 6 of the Customs Brokers Licensing Regulations, 2018, as amended, during the second quarter of the calendar year 2020. The pass percentage marks for qualifying in the oral examination will also be 60%.
